## Introduction

Nuclear weapons and nuclear energy are the main subject of the Eighth Conference of Parties to the Revised Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons (NPT), which takes place next May, at the United Nations.

Held every five years, the Conference of the Parties is the point at which the signatory states assess the fulfillment of commitments to the treaty and establish policies aimed at disarmament and nonproliferation of nuclear weapons. The current regime has been intensifying the problem among the major nuclear powers, which have been doing little for their own disarmament and prioritized the "Non-Proliferation", creating obstacles for the peaceful use of nuclear technology by developing nations.

According to this discussion, the Foreign Affairs Committee of the Brazilian Senate (CRE, in Portuguese) has approved the request of Senator Inácio Arruda, backed by Senate President Eduardo Azeredo and others to the workshop "The Revision of the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons. With the support of several institutions (Cebrapaz, WPC, FUNAG, CCAI, ABED and UnB), we believe the meeting will spread that debate within the Brazilian society, discussing the defense of peace with development for all.
